Again the word of the Lord came unto me, saying,

you far from the Lord: unto us is this land given in
possession. Therefore say, Thus saith the Lord God;

the countries where they shall come. Therefore say,

All sit for the SECOND LESSON Matthew 9: 35-end;
10: 1, 5-8

And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching
in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the
kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease
among the people. But when he saw the multitudes,
he was moved with compassion on them, because they
fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no
shepherd. Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest
truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye
therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send
forth labourers into his harvest.

And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples,
he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast
